

# Tony P's Seasonal and Rotating Beers (Bottles)



## Double Jack Imperial IPA, Firestone Brewery, Santa Ynez Valley, CA. (22 oz Bottle)

A big malty middle to cloak the high alcohol and mouth puckering hop bitterness. Huge tangerine, grapefruit and juicy fruit aroma blossom over the herbal blue basil and malt earthiness of this aggressive beer. ABV 9.5% 12



## Helios, (V Saison), Victory Brewing Company, Downingtown, Pennsylvania, (22 oz Bottle)

Bottle Conditioned, Belgium-inspired ale. An earthy, aromatic hop start and shifts into aspects of lemon peel and black pepper. This is a quenching, invigorating ale, despite its substantial strength. ABV 7.5% 10



## Franziskaner Hefe-Weisse Dunkel, Spaten-Franziskaner-Brau, Germany, (16.9oz Bottle)

A darker version of Hefe (Dunkel means dark) complex malts and a low balanced bitterness. A mild aroma of banana bread and apple sauce. Not overly-spiced and peppered. Worthy of Bavarian Kings since 1363. Making it the oldest privately owned brewery in Munich. ABV: 5% 8



## Mama's Little Yellow Piles, Oscar Blues Brewery, Lyons CO. (12 oz Can)

Small - batch version of the beer that made Pilsen, Czech Republic famous. Unlike mass market it is made with 100% pale malt, German specialty malts and Bavarian hops. Great session Beer ABV: 5.3% 6



Renegade Blonde, Iron Fist Brewing Co. Vista, CA. (750 mil Bottle) Great to share Kolsch style of beer. It's an ale that has a crispy malt flavor with a refreshingly bitter finish not unlike a lager. With age, it develops a mild, fruity character, like an ale. Very drinkable. ABV: 5.2% 13



## White Rascal, Avery Brewing Company, Boulder CO. (12 oz Bottle)

A truly authentic Belgian style wheat or "while Ale", this Rascal is unfiltered (yup, that's yeast on the bottom) and cleverly spiced with coriander and Curacao orange peel. Great with some of our spicy food. ABV: 5.6% 6



## Liberty Ale, Anchor Brewing, San Francisco, CA (12 oz Bottle)

Since 1975, In celebration of the 4th of July, A special top-fermenting ale yeast is used during fermentation and is responsible for many of the subtle flavors and characteristics. Carbonation is produced by an entirely natural process called "bunging," which produces champagne-like bubbles. Dry-hopping (adding fresh hops to the brew during aging), imparts a unique aroma to the ale. It is a process rarely used. ABV:5.9 % 6



## Delirium Tremens, Brouweij Huyghe Brewery Belgium. (330ml Bottle)

Belgium Strong Pale Ale. Has been voted the "Best Beer in the World" big title big beer. Sweet and yeasty on the nose. Belgium yeast, big but graceful sweetness, finishes dry. Clean and crisp. Dangerously drinkable and delicious. ABV: 8.5% 8.5
