



DELIRIUM RED (CAN)

Brouwerij Huyghe, Belgium
Deep dark red color with a light pink, and compact head and lacing. Soft fruity aroma, with hint of almond and slightly sour cherries. Sweet and fruity, with a nice balance between sweet and sour.

ABV: 8% 10



CALI CREAMIN' - VANILLA CREAM ALE (NITRO VERISON CAN)

Mother Earth Brew Co. Vista, CA
Lighter beer with a bit of Madagascar Vanilla Bean to give it that "Cream Soda" kick. This beer finishes dry despite a subtle perceived sweetness from the Vanilla. Very smooth! Great any time of year.

ABV: 5.5% 8



DOS EQUIS AMBAR ESPECIAL (DRAFT)

Cuauhtémoc Moctezuma Brewery, Monterrey, Mexico

The brand was named "Siglo XX" ("20th century") to commemorate the arrival of the new century, and the bottles were marked with the Roman numerals "XX", or "Dos Equis" (two X). Vienna Lager style from Mexico. Aromas and flavors are very mild but present. It's sweet but not cloying. Drinks nice and easy.

ABV: 4.7% 7.5



KEREL KAISHAKU (BOTTLE)

VBDC Brewery, Belgium
A Belgium strong (Suicide) blond pale ale. Surprisingly refreshing light bodied. Made with Sakeyeast. Very high in the boozy category!

ABV: 15% 10



CALIFORNIA HONEY (16OZ CAN)

Pizzeria Port Brewing, Carlsbad, CA
A Golden Ale, brewed with the addition of local California honey, this blonde ale is crisp and refreshing with a hint of sweetness and a smooth finish.

ABV: 4.8% 7



SHINER BOCK (DRAFT)

Spoetzl Brewery, Texas (Draft)
Tip back a bock. Brewed with rich roasted barley malt and German specialty hops, it is a lightly-hopped American-styled dark lager. One of those beers that just go down easy! The highest-selling beer in Texas.
